Tom Ripley is a nobody given an unexpected chance to make a name for himself. When he first meets Dickie Greenleaf, Tom's skills for forging signatures, telling lies and impersonating just about anybody are nothing more than impressive games. But as his friendship with Dickie becomes obsession, Tom's talents have very dangerous consequences. The Faction breathes fresh life into Patricia Highsmith's extraordinary psychological thriller about ambition, escapism and murder.

The Talented Mr. Ripley is a psychological thriller, an exciting and entertaining journey through one man's murderous mind.

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Ripley is an anti-hero on a Shakespearean scale, and the sense of his pursuit and paranoia like something from Greek tragedy. Highsmith's novel is a modern classic. The murders, the travel, the physicality and performance of 'being someone else,' all of this seemed perfect for a company with a vision for innovative interpretations of classic texts.

In many ways, all of my work has been about identity, from Shakespeare productions - Richard, Macbeth, Coriolanus (all anti-heroes!) and Hamlet, of course, - and Schiller - Fiesco and Mary Stuart. I'm fascinated by the individual, and what makes them tick, and how they interact with the world around them, and how we as an audience can perceive the world through their perspective. Ripley feels like the ideal continuation of that

Today's conversations about identities, both gendered and otherwise, give Ripley a certain timeliness.

Putting the work of a woman and pioneer of LGBTQ fiction on stage has a particular resonance at this time when female writers are still underrepresented.

LGBTQ themes within the text, especially the notion of queerness, of a resistance to labels and binary definitions, is pertinent in a time when individual self-determined identities are at the forefront of conversation.

Separate to that: the sense of our data selves, of the way we can appear privately and publicly - particularly on new platforms - and how we present ourselves, takes on significance in the identity fraud at the heart of the narrative.

At a time when the media and the commentariat is so absolute and lacking in nuance in its fixed labels, even the notion of an "anti-hero" and someone to whom you feel attached even as they're committing horrific acts, feels contemporary.
